NFL preseason statistical leaders were tracked in 2013 by the Elias Sports Bureau, official statisticians of the NFL.

Listed below are the final preseason leaders in the American and National Football Conferences. Rookie running back **KHIRY ROBINSON** of the New Orleans Saints was the NFL preseason rushing leader with 228 rushing yards. Wide receiver **STEPHEN WILLIAMS** of the Seattle Seahawks led the league in receiving yards with 236. The leading passer was Seattle Seahawks quarterback **TARVARIS JACKSON** with a 131.4 rating.

The Houston Texans finished the 2013 preseason with the top-ranked offense, averaging 444.3 yards per game. The San Francisco 49ers led the league in defense with a 205.8 yards-per-game average.
