## WHAT TO LOOK FOR – A LOOK BACK

**BREES-ING BY:** New Orleans quarterback **DREW BREES** passed for 237 yards and two touchdowns on Sunday against the Cleveland Browns.

Brees has now passed for 51,651 yards in his career, surpassing Pro Football Hall of Famer **JOHN ELWAY** (51,475) for fourth-most all-time.

**FABULOUS AT 50:** In his 50th career game on Sunday, Cincinnati quarterback **ANDY DALTON** completed 15 of 23 passes for 252 yards, a touchdown and a 116.6 passer rating in a 24-10 win over Atlanta. Dalton (11,913 passing yards in 50 career games) surpassed **AARON RODGERS** (11,746) for the fifth-most passing yards of any active quarterback through his first 50 games.
