<http://twitter.com/nfl345>**PACKERS RB EDDIE LACY, SEAHAWKS S KAM CHANCELLOR & EAGLES KR JOSH HUFF NAMED NFC PLAYERS OF WEEK 12**

Running back **EDDIE LACY** of the Green Bay Packers, safety **KAM CHANCELLOR** of the Seattle Seahawks and rookie kick returner **JOSH HUFF** of the Philadelphia Eagles are the NFC Offensive, Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week for games played the 12th week of the 2014 season (November 20, 23-24), the NFL announced today.

**OFFENSE: RB EDDIE LACY, GREEN BAY PACKERS**

- Lacy had 138 scrimmage yards, including 125 rushing yards, and scored two touchdowns (one rushing, one receiving) in the Packers' 24-21 win at Minnesota.
- He had a one-yard touchdown run to open the scoring in the first quarter and then gave Green Bay an 11-point lead with a 10-yard touchdown catch off a shovel pass with 8:34 remaining in the game.
- After the Vikings cut the Packers' lead to three with 3:28 left in the game, Lacy ran five consecutive times to gain 27 yards and two first downs to seal the victory by running out the clock.
- Lacy is the first running back in franchise history to gain at least 100 scrimmage yards and have a touchdown catch in three consecutive games.
- Lacy, who rushed for 105 yards against Minnesota in Week 5, joins **GALE SAYERS, WALTER PAYTON, BILLY SIMS** and **BARRY SANDERS** as the only players in NFL history to have two 100-yard rushing games against the Vikings in a single season.
- In his second season from Alabama, this is Lacy's second career Player of the Week Award (Week 15, 2013).
- He is the first Packer to be named Offensive Player of the Week in both his rookie and second season.
- Lacy and **AHMAN GREEN** (six times) are the only Green Bay running backs to be named Offensive Player of the Week multiple times.

**DEFENSE: S KAM CHANCELLOR, SEATTLE SEAHAWKS**

- Chancellor tied for the club lead with eight tackles, including a team-best seven solo tackles, in the Seahawks' 19-3 win over Arizona.
- He led a defensive unit that limited the Cardinals to 204 total net yards of offense (64 rushing, 140 passing), the fewest Seattle has allowed this season.
- Five of Chancellor's eight tackles came within three yards or behind the line of scrimmage, including two tackles for no gain.
- The Seahawks' 204 net yards allowed are the fewest by a team against an opponent that entered the game with a 9-1 or better record this late in the season since 2011 (Baltimore, 170 yards, November 24 vs. San Francisco).
- In his fifth year from Virginia Tech, this is Chancellor's second career Player of the Week Award and second this season (Week 3).
- Chancellor is the first Seahawks safety to be named Defensive Player of the Week twice in the same season.
- He joins cornerbacks **RICHARD SHERMAN** (2013) and **ROBERT BLACKMON** (1995) as the only Seahawks to be named Defensive Player of the Week multiple times in a single season.

**SPECIAL TEAMS: KR JOSH HUFF, PHILADELPHIA EAGLES**

- Huff returned the opening kickoff 107 yards for a touchdown, the longest score in franchise history, in the Eagles' 43-24 win over Tennessee.
- Huff and **CHRIS POLK** (102 yards, Week 3) have each recorded a 100+ yard kickoff-return touchdown this season for the Eagles. Philadelphia is the first team since the 1970 Green Bay Packers to have two players each return a kickoff 100+ yards for a touchdown.
- Nine different Eagles have scored a return touchdown, tied for the most in a single season in NFL history.
- Huff's 107-yard return touchdown is the second-longest on the opening kickoff in NFL history (**CORDARRELLE PATTERSON**, 109 yards).
- In his rookie season from Oregon, this is Huff's first career Player of the Week Award.
- Huff is the first Eagles rookie to be named Special Teams Player of the Week.

- New York Giants rookie wide receiver **ODELL BECKHAM, JR.**, who had 10 catches for 146 yards and two touchdowns.
- San Francisco wide receiver **ANQUAN BOLDIN**, who had nine catches for 137 yards and a touchdown in the 49ers' 17-13 win over Washington.
- Philadelphia running back **LE SEAN MC COY**, who rushed for 130 yards and a touchdown.
- Dallas quarterback **TONY ROMO**, who completed 18 of 26 passes (69.2 percent) for 275 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions for a 143.4 passer rating in the Cowboys' 31-28 win at the New York Giants.
