**COLTS QB ANDREW LUCK, BUFFALO DE MARIO WILLIAMS &  
RAVENS K JUSTIN TUCKER**  
**NAMED AFC PLAYERS OF MONTH FOR NOVEMBER**

Quarterback **ANDREW LUCK** of the Indianapolis Colts, defensive end **MARIO WILLIAMS** of the Buffalo Bills and kicker **JUSTIN TUCKER** of the Baltimore Ravens are the AFC Offensive, Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Month for November, the NFL announced today.

**OFFENSE: QB ANDREW LUCK, INDIANAPOLIS COLTS**

- Luck completed 88 of 144 passes (61.1 percent) for 1,280 yards with 12 touchdowns and two interceptions for a 112.0 passer rating in November.
- Luck led the Colts to a 3-1 record for the month, passing for at least 300 yards and two touchdowns with a passer rating of 100.0 or better in three of the four games.
- He passed for 354 yards and four touchdowns with no interceptions against the Giants in Week 9 on *Monday Night Football*, and followed with 303 yards and two touchdowns against New England in Week 11 following the bye week. He added 253 yards and one touchdown with no interceptions in a Week 12 win against Jacksonville.
- In Week 13 against Washington, Luck completed 19 of 27 passes for 370 yards and five touchdowns for a 137.0 passer rating.
- Luck leads the NFL with 4,011 passing yards this season and joined Pro Football Hall of Famer **DAN MARINO** and **PEYTON MANNING** as the only players in NFL history to pass for at least 4,000 yards in two of their first three seasons.
- In his third season from Stanford, this is Luck's first career Player of the Month Award. He is the second Colts player to win a Player of the Month Award in 2014, joining punter **PAT MC AFEE** (Special Teams, September).

**DEFENSE: DE MARIO WILLIAMS, BUFFALO BILLS**

- Williams led the AFC and tied for first in the NFL with 6.5 sacks and posted 11 tackles in four November games.
- He posted at least one sack in three of four games during the month, including a season-high 3.5 sacks against Miami in Week 11.
- Williams also posted two sacks in a Week 12 win against the Jets at Detroit's Ford Field and one sack against Kansas City in Week 10.
- Seven of Williams' 11 tackles this month were for a loss.
- He anchored a Bills defense that led the NFL in scoring for the month (13.0 points per game). Buffalo leads the NFL with 48 sacks this season.
- In his ninth season from North Carolina State, this is Williams' first career Player of the Month Award. Williams is the first Bill to be named Defensive Player of the Month since linebacker **SAM COWART** in 2000 (November).

**SPECIAL TEAMS: K JUSTIN TUCKER, BALTIMORE RAVENS**

- Tucker converted all seven field-goal attempts and all 12 PATs for a total of 33 points in four November games.
- Tucker was one of two AFC players with at least seven attempts and a perfect field-goal percentage this month.
- He has now made 93 of 102 career field-goal attempts (91.2 percent), the highest percentage in NFL history (minimum 100 attempts).
- Tucker also posted 17 touchbacks on 23 kickoffs (73.9 percent), the second-highest percentage in the AFC for November. He ranks second in the NFL with 50 touchbacks on kickoffs this season.
- In his third season from Texas, this is Tucker's second career Player of the Month Award (November 2013). He joins **MATT STOVER** (three) and **JERMAINE LEWIS** (two) as the only Ravens to win multiple Special Teams Player of the Month Awards.
